# Administrative History

Samuel Insull, born 1859 in London, moved to the United States in 1881. He purchased Hawthorn Farm from J. N. Barr in 1907. From 1914 to 1916, architect Benjamin Marshall and landscape architect Jens Jenson designed and built a new residence for Insull at Hawthorn Farm. John Cuneo, Sr. purchased Hawthorn Farm in 1937, followed by a foundation herd of dairy cattle in 1938. Over the next 25 years, Cuneo renamed the farm to Hawthorn-Mellody Farm, built a horse arena near the mansion, constructed a new dairy barn and parlor, and opened a Children's Zoo, Bar 20 Ranch, and Frontier Town.

When John F. Cuneo, Sr. died in 1977, he stated in his will that his mansion in Vernon Hills, Illinois, was to be used for "educational purposes" after his wife no longer used the house. When Mrs. Cuneo died, the mansion became part of the Cuneo Foundation. The Cuneo Museum and Gardens opened to the public under the legal control of the John F. and Julia Cuneo trust in 1991. The house remained as it was when it was a residence, with the exception of some cleaning, renovation, and the addition of display cases and memorabilia from the Cuneo's 1500 N. Lake Shore Drive apartment.

When it first opened, the museum mainly attracted people from the Vernon Hills vicinity. Over the next six years, the Cuneo Museum became a popular place for weddings, private events, concerts, movie settings, and other well-attended events including the annual Christmas light show. In December 2009, the mansion and grounds were gifted to Loyola University Chicago by John and Herta Cuneo, Jr.

#### Loyola University Chicago ~ Archives and Special Collections

The home has served as the backdrop of movies and television shows, including the 1993 CBS television series, *The Untouchables*, a crime series that chronicled the life of Al Capone; the 1997 film, *My Best Friend's Wedding*, starring Julia Roberts; and the 2008 film, *Witless Protection*. Tours of the mansion and grounds have showcased the gardens and extensive collection of medieval and Renaissance artwork.

## **Scope and Content**

The Cuneo Museum Records consists of 15.0 linear feet and spans the years 1961-2009. It consists of staff records, museum operations, scrapbooks, photographs, correspondence, newspaper and magazine clippings, cassette tapes, and VHS tapes. Folders are arranged alphabetically within the series, and folders of the same subject are arranged chronologically.

#### Series 1: Museum Operations, 1984-2009, no date, Box 1-4

This series contains materials relating to the day to day operations involved in running the museum and grounds, such as annual reports, catering, event issues, emergency procedures, incident reports, local government issues, planning, security, tickets, tools, equipment, and vendors.

#### Series 2: Staff Records, 1988-2001, no date, Box 4-8

This series contains materials relating to the employees of Cuneo Museum. Documents contain accounting information, attendance records, brochures, correspondence, tour scripts, docent records, ledgers, newsletter, and training information, liability and insurance information, job duties, procedural records, postage records, staff meeting minutes, visitor surveys, volunteer information, and 501(c)3 documentation.

#### Series 3: Maintenance, 1995-2003, Box 8-9

This series contains materials relating to repairs, supplies, electrical issues, equipment upkeep, lawn care, maintenance plans/reports, projects, rubbish removal, pathways maintenance, and tree services.

#### Series 4: Cuneo Collections, 1961, 1998, no date, Box 10

This series contains materials relating to the artwork housed at Cuneo Museum, information about specific paintings, and identification numbers for several artifacts.

#### Series 5: Curatorship, 1976-2000, no date, Box 10-11

This series contains accession and curatorial forms, conservation reports, correspondence with restoration organizations, information about exhibits, loan agreements, an IHSH award application, photo processing information, and several readings about curating, maintenance, education, art, and architecture.

#### Series 6: Financials, 1991-2008, Box 11-19

This series is divided into expenses, income, and summary financial information. Materials include bills, invoices, check registers, profit and loss forms, purchase orders, vendor receipts, deposits, grant and fundraising information, income statements, museum ledger sheets, budget comparisons, monthly statements, and weekly reports.

This series contains reports, flyers, plans, programs, correspondence, and brochures relating to the Botti Opera Showcase, brunches, event expenses, Packard, recitals and concerts, special events, Stage II, Valentine's Day, and Vernon Hill Street Dance.

#### Series 8: Advertising and Promotional Materials, 1995-2001, no date, Box 22-23

This series contains brochures, printing and publication information, public relations samples, publicity articles, and newsletters.

#### Series 9: Public Involvement and Outreach, 1995-2000, Box 23

This series contains correspondence, plans, reports, purchase orders, and flyers relating to the Children's Art Fair, education planning, the first member reception, membership income, and the outreach program at St. Joseph, Grayslake.

#### Series 10: Photographs, 1997-1999, no date, Box 23-24

This series contains photographs and negatives of Cuneo mansion, the interior of the house, and special events.

#### Series 11: Scrapbooks, 1993-2009, Box 24-26

This series contains ten scrapbooks of photographs, newspaper clippings, and magazine articles. The pages are in plastic sleeves, without the binder coverings.

#### Series 12: Audio Visual, 1978, 1992-1994, 1997-1998, 2002, no date, Box 27-28

This series contains nineteen VHS tapes and six cassette tapes about museums, Cuneo Museum events, and lectures.
