Biographical Sketch

Born in St. Louis, Missouri, on July 31, 1917, George Drury grew up in Chicago where he attended St. Mel's School, Quigley Seminary and St. Mary of the Lake, where he received his B.A. in philosophy. In 1948 Drury received his M.A. in Philosophy from Loyola University Chicago, followed in 1958 by a Ph.D. in philosophy from the University of Chicago.

In 1942 Bishop Bernard J. Sheil asked Drury to head an educational program designed to explore social and political problems in the light of modern religious, democratic, and ethical principles. This resulted in the Sheil School of Social Studies opening in 1943, and which Drury was the director of until 1946 when he went to Loyola University Chicago to pursue an M.A. in Philosophy and joined the philosophy faculty as an instructor. From 1959 to 1966 Drury was an Associate Professor of Social Science and Humanities at Monteith College, later Wayne State University. From 1971 until his retirement in 1987, Drury taught at Empire State College in New York.

In 1948 Drury married his wife Finvola, a poet, and they had two children – Finvola, a noted AIDS scientist and health worker who died in 1991, and George F. Drury passed away May 16, 2010, at the age of 92. Finvola Drury passed away January 19, 2015.

Scope and Content

The George F. Drury, Ph.D., papers comprise 2.0 linear feet spanning the years 1934 to 1998 (bulk 1943-1959) and include interviews, articles, notes, correspondence, yearbooks, programs, transcripts, minutes, lecture and talk notes, papers, schedules, reports, certificates, photos, books, magazines, newsletters, and pamphlets. Materials are mainly in English although some are in French. Subjects include George F. Drury,

Catholic Action, the Shiel School of Social Studies, the Calvert Club, the Catholic Young Organization, the Young Christian Students, and Paule Verdet.

Arrangement is chronological within series.

Series

Series 1: Biographical, 1995-1998, Undated. Box 1

This series includes an oral history interview with George F. Drury about the Sheil School on audio-cassette tape, articles, and an invitation and speech notes for the Drury's 50th wedding anniversary.

Series 2: Education, 1935, 1956-1958, Undated. Box 1

This series includes a yearbook from Quigley Preparatory Seminary, course schedules, syllabus, thesis proposal, and a copy of Drury's dissertation.

This series includes notes and schedules for the Calvert Club.

Series 8: Catholic Youth Organization, 1944-1946, 1950, undated. Box 2.

This series includes minutes, survey results, and articles relating to the Catholic Youth Organization.

Series 9: Sheil School of Social Studies, 1944-1946, undated. Box 2.

This series includes notes, programs, class schedules, news clippings, a certificate, and an article for early publicity.

<u>Series 10: Young Christian Students (Y.C.S.), 1934-1959, 1979, 1994, 1996, undated.</u> Boxes 3-4.
