Biographical Sketch

The Son of Joseph and Rae Wolf, Henry P. Wolf graduated from Loyola University Chicago with a master's degree in Anthropology in 1976. He returned to Loyola University Chicago in 1979 as a part-time faculty member teaching Anthropology 101 and Anthropology 102 from 1979 to 1981. In addition to his part-time faculty position at Loyola, he was a partner in the Arrow Sign Company, vice chairman of the board of trustees of Spertus College of Judaica in Chicago, and a founder of Temple Judea Mizpah in Skokie. He died on November 2, 1981, leaving a wife and three children.

Scope and Content

The Henry P. Wolf papers consist of 1.5 linear feet spanning the years 1968 to 1981 (bulk 1969 to 1976) and include syllabi, correspondence, papers, memos, minutes, notes, exams, articles, and a play script. Subjects include his time as an undergraduate at Northwestern University, his graduate work at Loyola University Chicago, and his work as a faculty member at Loyola University Chicago. Arrangement is chronological within series.

Series 1: Undergraduate Work at Northwestern University, 1968-1972, Undated
