Biographical Sketch

John Arthur Kemp, S.J., was born May 2, 1912 to Arthur A. and Katherine R. Cleary Kemp in Park Ridge, Illinois. He attended Park Ridge Public School, St. Paul of the Cross, and Saint Ignatius High School before entering the novitiate of Society of Jesus at Milford in 1930. Kemp studied philosophy at Maison St. Louis, at Jersey, England; Theology at West Baden and served his tertianship in Cleveland. He received a BA from Xavier University, an MA in History from Loyola University Chicago (1939), and an MA and PhD in History from Harvard University (1945-1952). Fr. Kemp taught at Loyola University Chicago, Xavier University, and University of Louvain in Belgium. Fr. Kemp specialized in legal and intellectual history of the Medieval Ages. Fr. Kemp passed away on November 26, 1963.

Scope and Content

The John A. Kemp, S.J., papers comprise 1.0 linear foot spanning the years 1930 to 1963 and include a brief biographical sketch, correspondence, thesis and papers, sermons, publications, syllabi, and lecture notes. Subjects include the Catholic Church, Jesuits, Saint Ignatius Loyola, Innocent IV, English monarchy, French monarchy, Medieval society and culture, and intellectual history. Languages include French and English.
