Administrative History

Established in 1983 the office of the Vice President of Student Services originated in 1929 as two separate offices for male and female students – the offices of the Dean of Men and the Dean of Women. These offices continued in existence until 1969. In 1946 the office of the Dean of Students was established with both the Dean of Men and Dean of Women reporting to the Dean of Students. In 1971 the former Dean of Men and Dean of Women offices were retitled Associate Dean of Students reporting to the Dean of Students. In 1983 the office of the Dean of Students was renamed the office of the Vice President of Student Services.

From 1951 to 1960 Mariette M. LeBlanc served as the Dean of Women at Loyola University Chicago, followed by the Associate Dean of Students from 1969 to 1972 and the Dean of Students from 1972 to 1974. In 1974 she was appointed by President Raymond C. Baumhart, SJ, as the Vice President for Student Services, a position she held until her retirement in 1987. Mariette LeBlanc was the first women Vice President at Loyola University Chicago.
