#### **Administrative History**

The Office of Multicultural Affairs was established in 1988, consolidating several student life positions and departments under one name. Those positions included the Hispanic Student Advisor, the Black Student Advisor (changed to African American Student Advisor with the creation of the new office), and the International Student Advisor. The office was designed to support diversity and multiculturalism on all Loyola University Chicago campuses, through programs, events, and other activities. The first dean was Helen Lavalle, former International Student Advisor. In 1991, Angeles Eames, former Hispanic Student Advisor and then head of the Hispanic Alliance, became dean. The Hispanic Alliance, a consortium with DePaul University and Mundelein College and sponsored by the Ford Foundation, was consolidated into the Office of Multicultural Affairs. Eames left the position in 1996, to become Director of Women's Programs and Services at Loyola University Chicago. By 2002 the Office of Multicultural Affairs had been folded into the Office of Student Development and Diversity, which in 2004 was split off again into the Office of Student Diversity. It is currently known as the Office of Student Diversity and Multicultural Affairs.



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### **Scope and Content**

The Office of Multicultural Affairs records comprise 9.0 linear feet spanning the years 1980-1997. The records consist of correspondence, program information, budget and grant documents, university forms, student surveys, financial information, policies and procedures, and program evaluations. Series are arranged either chronologically or alphabetically.

#### **Series**

#### Series 1: Correspondence, 1981-1990. Boxes 1-3

This series contains correspondence within the office and with other offices at the university, including memos, letters, and directives. Common topics in the correspondence are programs with other schools, progress reports on current programs, budget or grant issues, and general issues.

#### Series 2: Meetings and Minutes, 1984-1995. Boxes 3-4

This series contains meeting minutes and summaries of meetings from different divisions in the Office of Multicultural Affairs.

#### Series 3: Policies and Procedures, 1990-1997, Undated. Boxes 4-5

This series contains general forms, departmental goals and procedures, job application guidelines, training modules and retreat instructions.

#### Series 4: Projects, 1990-1995. Boxes 5-8

This series contains budget and grant information, conference records, and planning materials for university projects, including Project Common Ground, Unity in Diversity Week, and the Multicultural Affairs Conference. The series also includes several project proposals, a dissertation, a campus survey, and documents belonging to Project Enrichment, including photos and negatives, announcements and schedules, project guidelines and rules, and curricula.

#### Series 5: Events, 1988-1997. Boxes 8-9

This series contains schedules, reports and advertisements for workshops, day-or-week long events organized by the Office of Multicultural Affairs, retreats, and theater programming. It also contains records relating to the Conference on Minority Affairs, organized by the Association of Jesuit Colleges and Universities and attended by Dean Angeles Eames.

#### Series 6: Hispanic Alliance, 1980-1991, Undated. Boxes 9-12

This series contains budget information, grant proposals, program evaluations, anonymous surveys, financial aid forms, documentation of award banquets and the



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process in choosing the Hispanic Alliance Student of the Year, job training and descriptions, committee information, and documents relating to the Cultural Diversity and Liberal Education Conference, held at the University of Chicago campus.

#### Subseries 6-A: Clemente High School Program, 1983-1991. Boxes 10-12

Contains records about the peer counseling and tutoring program at Clemente High School (later Clemente Academy), developed in collaboration between Loyola University Chicago, DePaul University, and Mundelein College. Contains program evaluations and reports, peer counseling instructions and orientations, schedules, information about Clemente High School, records relating to the cultural program and summer programs also held at Clemente, anonymous student surveys, receipts and reimbursements, and planning materials.

# Series 7: Students Together Are Reaching Success (S.T.A.R.S.), 1988-1996, Undated. Boxes 12-13

This series contains records relating to the Students Together Are Reaching Success (S.T.A.R.S.) program, including grant and budget information, institutionalization proposals, program evaluations, and general forms.

#### Series 8: Hispanic Women's Program, 1985-1991, Undated. Box 13

This series contains records relating to the Hispanic Women's Program (H.W.P.), including budget information, events sponsored by the H.W.P., employee training, expansionary proposals, program outreach, and general forms.

#### Series 9: Academic Bridge Program, 1991. Box 13

This series contains evaluations of the Academic Bridge program, developed in collaboration with Truman College.

#### Series 10: Restricted, 1980-1995, Undated. Boxes 14-18

This series contains transcripts, student records, attendance records, rosters and directories, resumes and job applications, financials, salaries and wages, student surveys, and disciplinary incidents.
