Biographical Sketch

Joseph S. Pendergast, S.J., was born in Chicago on November 26, 1923, to Charles and Mary Pendergast. He attended Loyola Academy, graduating in 1941 and then entered the Society of Jesus. He was ordained in 1954. He received his A.B. in 1946 and a M.A. in Classical Languages in 1950 from St. Louis University, before earning a Ph.D. in Classical Philosophy in 1961 from the University of Illinois. Father Pendergast taught Classical Studies and held administrative appointments at a number of Jesuit educational institutions including St. Ignatius High School in Chicago, Xavier University in Cincinnati, and Loyola University Chicago.

During his time at Loyola University Chicago, Father Pendergast served as a professor of Classical Studies, Assistant Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences (1960-1961), Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences (1961-1964), and Chairman of the Department of Classical Studies (1972-1978). Within the Department of Classical Studies, he served as Graduate Program Director (1970-1978), Undergraduate Program Advisor (1985-1995), and Honors Program Advisor (1985-1995). Father Pendergast specialized in Greek and Latin literature, ancient world mythology, the writings of Greek and Roman historians, and Ancient Greek and Roman religion. Among his publications were *The Philosophy of History of Pompeius Trogus* (1961) and numerous articles.

Father Pendergast passed away on May 3, 1995 at Loyola University Medical Center in Maywood.

Scope and Content

The Joseph S. Pendergast papers consist of 2.75 linear feet spanning the years 1924-1993 (bulk 1941-1981) and consist of correspondence, lecture notes, class exams, sermons, and translations of medical texts. Subjects covered are include Loyola University Chicago, St. Ignatius College, retreats, College of Arts and Sciences, Classical Studies, Correspondence Study Division, and classes. Languages include English, Latin and Greek.

Arrangement is chronological.

Series

Series 1: Personal, 1944-1991, Undated. Box 1

This series includes correspondence, notes, photos, and publications relating to Fr. Pendergast's time at Loyola Academy, Milford Novitiate, and as a Jesuit.

Series 2: Sermons and Retreats, 1941-1967, Undated. Boxes 1-2

This series includes sermons, notes, and schedules.

Series 3: Teaching, 1924-1989, Undated. Boxes 2-3

This series includes lecture notes, course descriptions, lesson plans, evaluation templates, outlines, vocabulary sheets and class handouts relating to Fr. Pendergast's teaching at St. Ignatius High School and Milford. Some class materials are in Greek or Latin.

Series 4: Loyola University Chicago, 1962-1980, Undated. Boxes 3-5

This series includes meeting minutes, handbooks, cv's, reports, correspondence, translations, lesson plans, outlines, lecture notes, and exams.

Series 5: Restricted, 1976-1993, Undated. Box 6

This series includes correspondence, transcripts and exams.
