Biographical Sketch

Rev. Louis P. Rogge, O. Carm, was born February 12, 1930, in Louisville, KY to the late Louis H. and Susan Rogge. He professed his vows with the Carmelites on October 15, 1952 and was ordained a priest July 4, 1954. Rogge was an educator and Parish priest, and was active in the Charismatic Renewal Movement.

Scope and Content
