Biographical Sketch

Peter Theodore Swanish was born in Minneapolis, Minnesota, on April 21, 1895. Educated at the University of Minnesota, Swanish began his distinguished career as a professor of economics at Loyola University Chicago in 1921. He earned an M.B.A. degree (1924) from Northwestern University and a Ph.D. (1930) from the University of Chicago, writing his dissertation <u>The Taxation of Agricultural Classes in Soviet Russia</u>.

In 1931 Swanish became the chair of the Department of Economics, Accounting, and Finance in the School of Commerce, later the School of Business Administration, at Loyola University Chicago, a post he held for 15 years. While at Loyola he conducted a major lecture series on revolutionary changes in the economic organization of Soviet Russia.

From 1934 to 1937 Swanish was the Chief of Research and Statistics for the Illinois Department of Labor, and from 1937 to 1942 he was the Commissioner of Unemployment Compensation for the State of Illinois. His responsibilities included collection and analysis of labor economic data, particularly with respect to labor and management relations, and developing and recommending standards for improving state compensation laws. Swanish left the position of Commissioner of Unemployment Compensation in 1942 to become director of research for the Railroad Retirement Board.

From 1945 to 1949 Swanish was the director for Industrial Relations at the Quality Hardware and Machine Corporation in Chicago, Illinois. During this time he served on various congressional committees and assisted the Director of Vocational Rehabilitation and Education for the Veterans Administration.

In 1949 Swanish returned to academe as the chair of the Department of Industrial Management and director of the Small Business Management Development Plan for the School of Business Administration, Loyola University Chicago. He retired from Loyola University Chicago in 1964, after 25 years on the faculty. Following his retirement from Loyola University Chicago ~ Archives & Special Collections Loyola, Dr. Swanish accepted a position as a visiting professor at Northern Illinois University, where he remained until his death on August 15, 1971.

A recognized expert in the areas of economic studies, personnel administration, and labor relations, Peter T. Swanish contributed much to the literature of economics and business management. He was a member of the Illinois State Small Business Advisory Council, Method-Time Measurement Association, Industrial Relations Research Association, Society of the Advancement of Management, American Economics Association, and national Council for the Development of Small Business Management.

Scope and Content

The Peter T. Swanish, Ph.D., papers consist of 11.0 linear feet spanning the years 1921 to 1971and include correspondence; reports; term papers; dissertation research materials and draft chapters; notes; pamphlets; articles; lectures; minutes; and conference proceedings. Most materials in the collection relate to Swanish's non-academic activities, although some material does relate to his time on the faculties of Loyola University Chicago and Northern Illinois University. Languages in the collection are English, Russian, and German; some notes are in shorthand.

<u>Series</u>

Series 1: Education, 1921-1933, 1942, 1962, n.d., Boxes 1-3

This series consists of report cards; transcripts; dissertation chapter drafts; notes; term papers; doctoral exams; papers; and book reviews. This series also includes sketches of Mr. & Mrs. Swanish by Ivan Gorich; a certificate appointing Swanish to the Illinois State Small Business Advisory Council; and Swanish's orders from the War Department. Subjects include Soviet Russia, taxation, Communism, Marxism, and Socialism. Some materials are in Russian and some notes are written in shorthand.

Series 2: Correspondence, 1927, 1930-1971, Box 4

This series is arranged chronologically and consists of correspondence and telegrams received by Swanish in the course of academic and non-academic work. Subjects include unemployment compensation; Japan-Russia conflict over Manchuria; taxation; Commission on Inter-State Cooperation; Committee on Hours of Labor; Interstate Conference on Labor Compacts; and small business.

Series 3: Academic Work, 1927-1933, 1945-1971, Boxes 4-9

This series consists of lectures; notes; book reviews; correspondence; course notes; articles; brochures; reports; and student papers. Subjects include Soviet Union; taxation; agriculture in the Soviet Union; health care; economics; economic history of the United States; cost of living; business management; business ethics; communication and language; and small business administration. This series is divided into two subseries – subseries 1: Loyola University Chicago, and subseries 2: Northern Illinois University.

Series 4: Non-Academic Work, 1933-1967, Boxes 9-18

This series consists of reports; surveys; minutes; proceedings; statements; legislation; presentation materials; rules and regulations; memorandums; draft amendments; articles; case files; and manuals. Subjects include taxation; Interstate Labor Conference; unemployment; social security; labor relations; National War Labor Board; Veteran's Administration; and Swanish's consulting work.

Series 5: Writings, Reports, and Addresses, 1923, 1931-1969, n.d., Boxes 18-20

This series consists of articles; reports; book reviews; and addresses in published and manuscript form by Swanish and others. Subjects include Soviet Russia; taxation; health care; social security legislation; unemployment; business administration; and small business management.

Series 6: Publications used for Research, 1930-1969, Boxes 21 - 22

This series consists of pamphlets, articles, and books used by Swanish in his research. Materials are mainly in English and Russian, although some articles are in German. Subjects include labor relations; sales training; health care; health insurance; interstate compacts; Soviet Union; and Russia.
