### Scope and Content

The Wilhelmi Collection consists of 8.63 linear feet (3.62 cubic feet) spanning the years 1882 to 1967 (bulk 1891 to 1949) and is comprised of song books and individual sheet music for popular songs from the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. Composers include Harry Askst, Egbert van Alstyne, Irving Berlin, Hoagy Carmichael, George M. Cohan, Sammy Fain, George Gershwin, Jimmie V. Monaco, Richard Rodgers, Jean Schwartz, Albert von Tilzer, and Harry Warren. Subjects include Irish ballads, Baseball songs, Minstrel music, novelty songs, Patriotic music, and World War I.
