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### College/School Reference for Advising Student Athletes

Division I student-athletes have five calendar years from the first enrollment at a two- or four- year school to compete four seasons of competition. Below are guidelines for advising SA's.

- Regardless of the degree sought, there are certain minimum requirements. The student is responsible for knowledge of the detailed requirements of the degree selected and any special requirements of the major and/or minor; including prerequisites.
- Our department requires SA's to register for a minimum of 15 degree eligible credit hours per semester.
  - Exception, for SAs ahead in hours 12 hrs. with 6 of those credit hours applicable to major/core/school/college required & minimum degree requirements.
  - Exception, hours left towards degree requirements towards graduation.
- Student athletes cannot drop a class. They must see their Academic Advisor and obtain a form which must be signed by their coach.  
IMPORTANT NOTE: Seniors who have applied for graduation cannot drop any classes without presenting their degree audit to their SA Advisor.
- In order for any SA to be eligible for competition, the SA must have successfully completed six hours of degree credit during the immediate preceding regular academic term (excluding summer): major, core, school/college requirements.
- Student athletes must complete/pass at least 18 degree eligible credit hours during the last two regular semesters of study and 24 credit hours in an academic year (with Summer)
- Student athletes are required to declare a major by the start of the 5th semester of study. Junior and senior student athletes cannot change their major without review and approval of the Compliance Officer and the Deputy Director in Athletics.
- No SA can change a primary major without a degree audit. We must insure that a change in major doesn't impact degree progress within the terms of an SA's eligibility;
- Student Athletes must successfully complete and/or transfer enough credit hours to meet the following progress towards degree conferral.
  - Start of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Year -5<sup>th</sup> semester: 40% (48 hours) of the degree requirements
  - Start of the 4<sup>th</sup> Year -7<sup>th</sup> semester: 60% (72 hours) of the degree requirements
  - Start of the 5<sup>th</sup> Year- 9<sup>th</sup> semester: 80% (96 hours) of the degree requirements
- Student Athletes must be compliant according to Loyola University's governing standards applicable to good academic standing with a minimum 2.00 CUM GPA. And, they must also be in good standing as defined by their school/college and, or major. School/s of Education and Nursing minimum GPA requirements are higher.
- Once a student completes the minimum requirements for degree conferral they must graduate. Only one major is required for degree conferral. If a student is a double major and meets all minimum degree requirements for one major but not the other, and has met core/school requirements they must graduate.
