Summer Undergraduate Program

Mayo Clinic seeks applicants for its 2024 summer undergraduate program in empirical bioethics research. Up to six students will be selected to participate.

The Summer Undergraduate Program in Biomedical Ethics Research provides students with an unparalleled research experience to prepare them for careers in healthcare, science, law, or bioethics.

Each student is placed with a faculty mentor to contribute to a particular ethics research project, lasting approximately 10 weeks, beginning in late May or early June. In addition to conducting mentored research, students also receive a robust ethics education curriculum.

Candidates must attach the following to the online application:

- Cover letter describing career goals and how biomedical ethics research relates to those goals
- Resume/CV
- 5-10 page writing sample, preferably on a topic in biomedical ethics
- Current, unofficial college transcript
- Two letters of recommendation from research mentors or undergraduate professors sent directly to Dr. Richard Sharp at bioethics@mayo.edu

QUALIFICATIONS

Successful applicants will be:

- Committed to pursuing a career related to biomedical ethics
- Able to work independently
- Proficient in written and verbal communication
- Highly motivated to learn new research methods
- Currently be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program
- Able to pass a background check and postoffer placement assessment prior to their start date
