- ☐ Explore alumni mentor career paths

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### YEAR 2

- ☐ Connect with Career Services about career research and ways to build skills
- ☐ Take a career class or workshop
- ☐ Try a job shadow or informational interview
- ☐ Secure an internship or volunteer in a relevant field
- ☐ Attend 1 career fair or graduate school fair and 1 networking event
- ☐ Schedule a meeting with an alumni mentor

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### YEAR 3

- ☐ Schedule time with Career Services to discuss strategies to gain experience
- ☐ Schedule a mock/practice job interview
- ☐ Schedule 3 career workshops and 3 informational interviews
- ☐ Secure an internship or volunteer in a relevant field
- ☐ Take on a leadership role in a group
- ☐ Attend 2 career fairs or graduate school fair and 3 networking events
- ☐ Seek internship advice from an alumni mentor

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### YEAR 4

- ☐ Meet with Career Services to develop plans for life after graduation
- ☐ Conduct 5 informational interviews
- ☐ Attend 4 career workshops or attend a career class
- ☐ Secure an internship or volunteer in a relevant field
- ☐ Attend 2 career fairs or graduate school fair and 4 networking events
