Eligibility: Residents who reside in condominium buildings, apartment buildings, or private homes within Loyola-serviced boundaries in the Rogers Park and Edgewater communities. The serviced boundaries are east to Lake Michigan, south to Glenlake Ave., west to Glenwood Ave. and north to Pratt Blvd.

Availability and Location of Parking: Parking for this program is available in the Main Structure located at 1110 W. Sheridan Rd. The University Community Guest Parking Program permits are valid M-F, 5 p.m. – 2 a.m., and Sat-Sun, 5 a.m.- 2 a.m. Blackout dates may apply.
