Register For Your Appointment

1. Visit our NEW COVID-19 vaccine scheduling site:
empower.health

Please note, this is not the same registration site used for EHS screening/flu events. You will need to create a new account.

2. Complete "New User" fields and enter client code:

Do not share client code outside of eligible participants

3. Register for your appointment

4. Download and print your requisition

Prior To Your Appointment

1. Bring a printed copy of your requisition (REQUIRED)

2. Please read your vaccine fact sheet (above), vsafe and VAERS before you are vaccinated

3. Review our COVID-19 Questionnaire (if you can answer "yes" to any of the questions, please do not attend your appointment)

4. Wear short or loose-fitting sleeves as access to your upper arm will be necessary

- Registration closes at NOON the business day prior to your event.
- To ensure social distancing, please arrive at your appointment time. We ask that you do not come early.
- Please wear a mask covering both your mouth and nose upon entry to the building.
- You will need to remain in the vaccination area for a minimum of 15 minutes post-injection.
