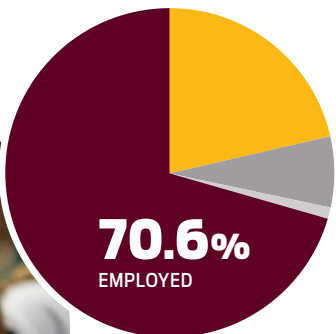

SCHOLARSHIPS

International undergraduate students are eligible for merit scholarships ranging from \$14,000 to \$31,000 per year. All students will be considered for a scholarship upon submitting their application.

Loyola also offers additional scholarships based on talent and academic interest. If you are eligible to file the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), you may be eligible for grants, loans, and the federal work-study program.

TUITION AND FEES (2025–26)

- Tuition (per year) \$54,530
- Fees \$1,530
- Room and Board (average per year) \$17,920
- Estimated Annual Expense \$73,980

Total estimated university expenses for a full-time student living on campus, with meals and city public transit pass included.

This does not include transportation to Chicago, books, course materials, and other personal expenses.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Online Application
- Official Transcripts (from high school or post-secondary school if you are a transfer student)
- SAT/ACT scores are optional and may be self-reported
- English Proficiency Exam (TOEFL, IELTS, Pearson Test of English, Duolingo English Test)
- Letters of Recommendation (incoming first-year students only)

Additional documentation in support of an application for a student visa may be required.
