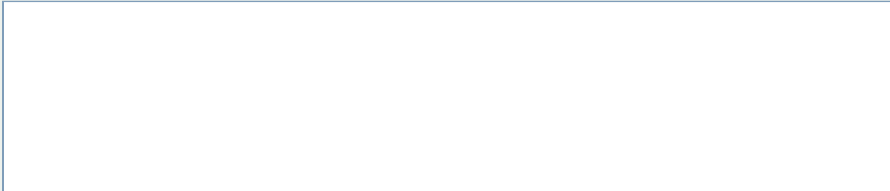

Four Loyola programs – women's cross country, women's golf, women's soccer and women's track and field – were honored by the NCAA with Public Recognition Awards for their outstanding Academic Progress Rate scores. According to the latest figures released by the NCAA in 2018-19, Loyola was ranked No. 2 in the nation with a 99 percent Graduation Success Rate (GSR). The Ramblers have ranked among the top three in the nation for four straight years, including a pair of seasons tied for the top spot in NCAA Division I. Once again, a handful of Ramblers were lauded for their outstanding achievements on the court and in the classroom. Both Clayton Custer (men's basketball) and Marius Kullmann (men's soccer) were selected as Google Cloud Academic All-Americans for their pursuit of excellence in the classroom. For the second straight year, the men's basketball program produced an All-America selection, with senior Marques Townes taking home the honor in 2018-19.
