John Schreiber grew up in Chicago and attended Loyola Academy in Wilmette for high school. He graduated from Loyola's undergraduate School of Business Administration in 1968, continued on to Harvard Business School, and then spent 20 years in real estate investment management. After he retired from JMB Realty Corp., he founded the New York based Blackstone Group's real estate investment management business.

## Schreiber scholarship support available:

### 1) Arrupe College Scholarship

Arrupe College is a two-year college of Loyola University Chicago that continues the Jesuit tradition of offering a rigorous liberal arts education to a diverse population, many of whom are the first in their family to pursue higher education.
