


Terms & Current Responses

- Refugee
 - Asylee 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(42)(A)
- Migrant
- Internally Displaced Persons ("IDP") & Forcibly Displaced Persons ("FDP")
- Temporary Protective Status (United States & Europe)
 - Ukrainians who were in the US prior to March 1, 2022 - US
 - Those arriving at ports of entry/border post March
 situation is unclear US
- Parole "<u>Uniting for Ukraine</u>" campaign
- MPP "Migrant Protection Protocol"


