MASTER OF LAWS (LLM) IN COMPLIANCE AND ENTERPRISE RISK (ONLINE)

The Master of Laws (LLM) degree is directed toward attorneys who seek advanced education in regulatory compliance and Enterprise Risk Management. Practical in application, the LLM will help students develop skills in regulatory analysis, compliance, counseling and program operation, and representation. The program is offered entirely online.

PROGRAM DETAILS

LENGTH OF PROGRAM: The LLM can be completed in 2 years on a part-time basis, though flexible completion options are available. The program requires 24 hours of coursework, including drafting a paper of publishable quality on an approved compliance or risk topic. The online program offers start times in the fall, spring, and summer of each year.

ACCELERATED OPTION: Under the accelerated option, LLM degree candidates are required to complete 18 credit hours of study. The accelerated option is only available to those who have completed coursework at Loyola's School of Law as JD students. LOCATION: The LLM in Compliance and Enterprise Risk Management is an entirely online program. The online option is only available to attorneys who have a minimum of 3 years of legal and/or business experience.

LLM IN COMPLIANCE AND ENTERPRISE RISK MANAGEMENT

The LLM in Compliance and Enterprise Risk Management offers a comprehensive study of the law as it relates to compliance, privacy management, securities law, risk management, and corporate counseling.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- A completed online application available at gpem.LUC.edu/apply
- Official transcripts of all undergraduate and any graduate work; transcripts must verify completion of a bachelor's degree and a primary law degree (e.g., JD or LLB)
- One optional letter of recommendation
- A one- to two-page statement of purpose
- A resume outlining your work experience, education, professional or academic achievements, or any information you believe is relevant for your application

The following documents are required, in addition to those listed above, for those who may fall into these categories:

- Either an official TOEFL or IELTS score report for international applicants. This requirement is waived for those who have completed a 4-year bachelor's or a master's degree program in the U.S. For those holding a non-U.S. bachelor's degree, applicants wishing to apply for a waiver must submit U.S. transcripts that show that they have also earned a U.S. master's degree. The language test is also waived for those who are from, or who have completed a bachelor's or master's degree at a recognized institution in, Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, or the United Kingdom, where the language of instruction is English.
- International applicants or U.S. residents who completed school abroad are required to submit non-U.S. transcripts to one of the following: Educational Perspectives (edperspective.org), Educational Credential Evaluators (ece.org), or the Law School Admission Council (lsac.org) for evaluation of credentials. The general evaluation report must show that an applicant's non-U.S. education is equivalent to a U.S. bachelor's degree to be considered for admission.

Spring Term: December 1

Summer Term: April 1
