### PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Structured in an accelerated framework and designed for busy executives like you, classes meet every other Saturday for 20 months. This convenient format allows you to learn and advance your career while maintaining work-life balance.

Classes take place at Loyola's Water Tower Campus. Approximately 20% of classes will take place online.

You will take cross-functional courses that offer a breadth of exposure to the disciplines well-rounded leaders must master. The program launches and concludes with an immersion weekend. Students complete the program with a final capstone project.
