

MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION IN HEALTH CARE MANAGEMENT

MBA DEGREE

Today's evolving health care industry calls for leaders who demonstrate innovation and leadership in the face of growing change. Quinlan School of Business's MBA in Health Care Management (HCM) program develops health care professionals who are effective, socially responsible leaders possessing the knowledge, skills, and understanding to succeed in any segment of this increasingly complex industry.

The program draws upon the expertise of faculty from Loyola's nationally recognized schools of business and law. You'll participate in a rigorous MBA program designed to build business knowledge, analytic, and strategic leadership skills, while also learning the latest practical applications in health care management. Two-thirds of the curriculum consists of industry-specific courses.

Qualified candidates for admission must have a minimum of 7 years of professional health care experience. On average, admitted students have 12 years of work experience.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

- Classes meet twice a month, every other Saturday
- Program takes 24 months to complete
- Life-changing international immersion
- A new cohort begins each Fall
- June 1 application deadline

Structured in a cohort format and designed for busy professionals like you, classes meet every other Saturday for 24 months. This convenient format allows you to learn and advance your career while maintaining work-life balance.

Classes take place at Loyola's Water Tower Campus. The program comprises 17 cross-functional courses that offer a breadth of exposure to disciplines well-rounded health care leaders need. Eleven courses are specific to the health care industry. The program features a capstone project. A modest number of classes take place online.

A global immersion experience is required. You will explore global issues through a 10-day industry-specific international immersion trip designed specifically for the cohort. Past cohorts have visited China, the United Arab Emirates, South Africa, countries in Europe and South America.
