

CERTIFICATE IN INSTRUCTIONAL COACHING

The Certificate in Instructional Coaching offers the opportunity to build teacher leadership for professional advancement without having to earn the principal licensure. Instructional coaching leads to increased learning for students by supporting evidence-based instructional practices with classroom teachers. This program will create a valid path to leadership and a method for professional advancement.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The program consists of four 3-credit courses, all offered online. Over these courses, you will create an implementation plan for instructional coaching within schools. You will also develop the elements of instructional coaching: assessment for learning, delivery of effective curriculum, enhancement of classroom instruction, and effective classroom management.

Upon completion of this program, you will understand how to develop supportive, confidential, and trustworthy relationships with teachers, distinguish between coaching and evaluating, explore conferencing, facilitation, presentation, and best practices for training.

PROGRAM DISTINCTIONS

There are many teachers that are asked to be instructional coaches as part of their jobs. However, many do this without professional training. In this program, you will work collaboratively to share knowledge, skills, and experiences, refine understanding of content, while giving and receiving feedback. This certificate will also help you prepare for the principal preparation program because three of the core courses could be applied to the core requirements of the MEd in Administration and Leadership.
