Directions to Campus from the Center of Rome:

Our campus can easily be reached from the center of Rome via taxi or public transportation.

Taxi:

A taxi to our campus from the center of the city costs approximately €20 on average. This price can vary depending on time of day, traffic, and starting location. For more information about taxi fares, please see:

Please note that it is not possible to “flag” a taxi in Rome. You must either call the taxi to come pick you up or find a taxi at an official taxi stand. Taxi stands are denoted by the orange “TAXI” signs:



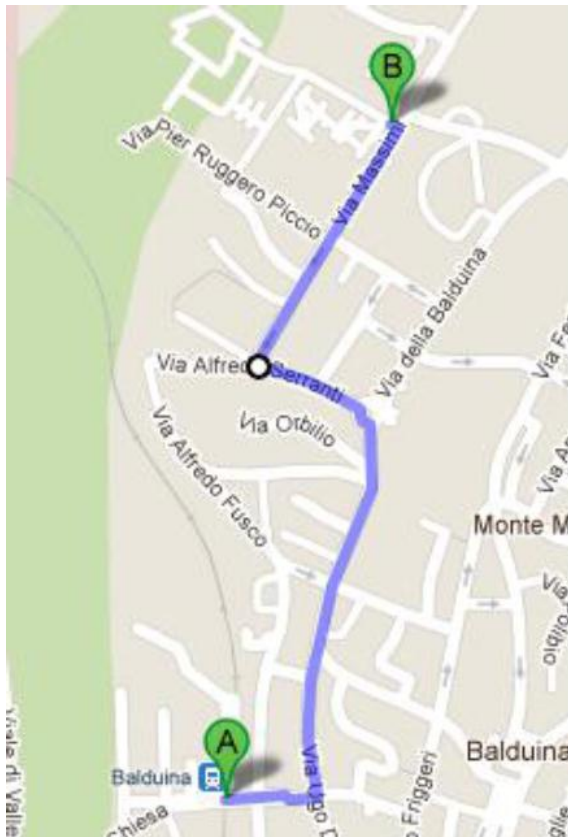
To call a taxi, dial (+39) 06.3570.

Train:

Our campus is located near the “Balduina” train station, along the FR3 commuter train line.

Trains can be taken from the “Ostiense” or “Trastevere” stations in the direction of “Viterbo,” “Cesano di Roma,” or “Bracciano.”

From the “Balduina” train station, it is about a 15-20 minute walk uphill to our campus:



- When exiting the Balduina train station, take a left.
- At the first stoplight, take another left.
- Walk uphill until you reach a traffic circle.
- Take a left at the traffic circle.
- Walk down that street and take a right onto “Via Massimi” (second street on the right after the traffic circle).
- At the end of Via Massimi you will see a tree in the middle of the road. Our gate is the green gate near that tree.
- Enter the gate and walk down the driveway. Our campus is the first gate on the right at the end of the driveway.
