Requirements

- 1) Commitment of at least 2 years (maximum of 3 years)
- 2) Interest in pursuing one of the following graduate degrees:
 - ★ Divinity,
 - ★ Pastoral Studies,
 - ★ Christian Spirituality,
 - ★ Social Justice
 - ★ Social Work.
 - These are the only degrees offered through the Magis program. Dual degrees are not offered through Magis.
- 3) Interest in completing field experiences in a Catholic Agency in the city of Chicago.
- 4) Willingness to participate in a formation program, grounded in the Jesuit tradition, and focusing on these five areas:
 - ★ Community
 - ★ Spirituality
 - ★ Antiracism
 - ★ Social Justice
 - ★ Sustainable Living
- 5) **Candidates must apply for admission to Loyola University Chicago.**
 - ★ Acceptance into Magis is contingent upon acceptance into Loyola University Chicago.

Instructions

Application Instructions

Most of the information needed by Magis will be obtained from your Loyola University Chicago Graduate School application. Therefore, the LUC graduate application must be completed first, and acceptance into LUC verified when applying to Magis.

However, the Magis office needs one additional item. Email is the preferred method of submission.

1. Personal Statement

It is a tradition in the Magis program that each year participants write a personal statement. The application to the Magis program is your personal statement. The personal statement is a statement that expresses who you want to be in the coming year in the following areas:

- As a Graduate Student
- As a person committed to building Community with the Magis cohort.
- As a person committed to spiritual formation
- As a person committed to living sustainably
- As a person committed to social justice
- As a person committed to anti-racism and dismantling white supremacy

This is generally at least a full page. You can write in paragraphs, bullet points or statements/phrases. It is suggested that this not be more than two pages. This helps to reflect and get clear, in a succinct way, as to whom you want to be as relates to the above areas.
