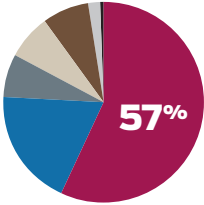

Employment Information for 2020 Graduates

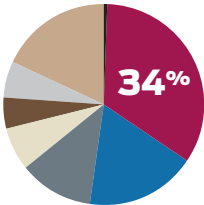
EMPLOYED BY JOB TYPE*
