Kevin C. Rasp is a partner at O'Hagan Meyer's Chicago office. When cases were not resolved at the Medical Review Panel stage, Kevin defended his healthcare clients as their medical malpractice cases continued in state court.

While in Indiana, Kevin also defended products liability and personal injury cases from the initial stage of investigation through discovery, mediation, and trial. He represented clients in courtrooms across the state, from South Bend to Bedford, from Knox to New Castle. Kevin maintains his Indiana license so regularly represents clients in the State of Indiana.

When Kevin returned to Chicago, his practice focused on the defense of products liability, wrongful death, and mass tort cases in Illinois, Indiana and around the country. He managed a varied and challenging caseload where he had the opportunity to depose expert witnesses, lead trial teams, and brief a successful appeal.

Now at O'Hagan Meyer, Kevin has a diverse practice. He defends healthcare providers in cases alleging medical malpractice, wrongful death, or violations of the Nursing Home Care Act.
