Global Climate Meeting in Paris: Success or Failure?

Andreas Carlgren is the former Swedish Minister for the Environment (2006-2011). During his term, Carlgren participated in several UN conferences on climate change, including the Copenhagen conference (2009), where Carlgren led the EU environment ministers. Additionally, Carlgren facilitated the climate change negotiations in Mexico (2010), and was a key minister involved in the UN negotiations on biodiversity in Japan (2010), resulting in the Nagoya Protocol on Genetic Resources.
