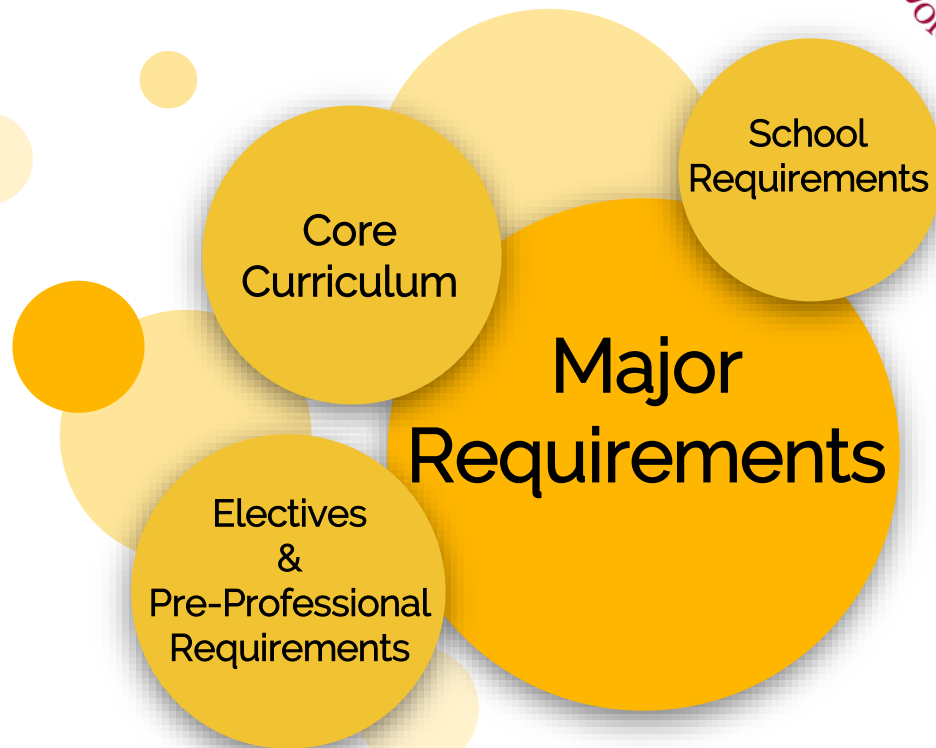

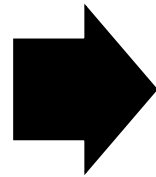
Each major is unique.
