### **Intensive Elementary Polish Language Course**

Loyola's Polish Studies Program is pleased to offer a new summer course in Elementary Polish for Research Purposes thanks to generous grant from the American Council of Learned Societies.

**PREREQUISITES: NO PRIOR KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED.** This eight-week course provides a comprehensive introduction to modern Polish for those who would like to speak Polish or use the language for reading and research. All four major communicative skills (reading, writing, listening comprehension, and speaking) are stressed. The course covers a selection of texts, printed and electronic media and academic literature. Class size is limited and admission is competitive.

Class meets 5 hours per day, Monday through Friday, for a total of 90 contact hours. Students will receive 6 credits upon successful completion of the course. The tuition for this 8 week program is waived for graduate students specializing in any discipline of Central and East European studies.
