

# WHAT TO BRING FOR MOVE-IN DAY

## Essentials

- Clothing
- Bed linens (twin XL), pillows, and blankets
- Towels/washcloths
- Mobile phone, charger, accessories
- Basic first-aid supplies
- Medications
- Toiletries
- Waste basket and bags

## Other

- Some dishes/flatware/pots and pans
- Blue painter's tape and/or removable mounting putty
- Power strips/surge protectors
- Hangers

## Think Green

- Reusable water bottle
- Pack with plastic bins or laundry basket
- Use linens to wrap fragile items
- Avoid single use products

## Desk/Study

- Computer and accessories
- Notebooks, folders, binders
- Pens/pencils/highlighters
- Calendar/planner
- Calculator
- Batteries



## Cleaning

- Laundry detergent/dryer sheets
- Laundry bag/basket
- Bathroom/surface cleaner
- Vacuum cleaner



# WHAT NOT TO BRING FOR MOVE-IN DAY

## NOT Allowed

- Adhesive strips (i.e. 3M command strips)
- LED adhesive light strips
- Sofas, futons, and other excess furniture
- Air conditioning units (all rooms have air conditioning)
- Appliances with exposed heating elements
- Extension cords
- Electric blankets
- Kerosene or electric heaters
- Hot plates or toaster ovens
- Deep fat fryers or electric grills
- High wattage microwaves
- Halogen lamps
- Candles/incense
- Pets (except fish)
- Heirlooms/expensive jewelry
- Motorbikes or hoverboards
- Weapons
- Alcohol or alcohol containers (if under 21)
- Minifridges bigger than 4.2 cu.ft., more than 1 minifridge per room, or any minifridges if living in an apartment-style dorm
- Water beds or other water filled furniture
- Power tools (i.e., drills, saws)
