## HEALTHCARE ADMINISTRATION MINOR

The Healthcare Administration minor prepares students to work in healthcare settings and to understand the business side of public health and health care. The minor is built upon a foundation of Jesuit-based liberal arts, business and public policy. Students will gain:

- Basic healthcare literacy
- Introduction to a wide array of healthcare trends and issues
- Insights into the operations of the multi-faceted healthcare industry

Students adding the Healthcare Administration minor to their course of study choose from a range of classes related to the health system: healthcare fiscal management, health information technology, health policy, health equity, healthcare strategy and marketing, management of healthcare organizations. Minors may choose from one of four Service-Learning courses that offer community-based experience and professional interaction.
