With regards to *Transparency*, there has been an identifiable lack of transparency between administration, faculty, and students concerning the financial decisions of Loyola and the overall academic decision-making process. Jacob and I will promote increased accessibility to financial documents, the changes made to those documents year-to-year, and the reasoning behind said changes. Furthermore, we seek to unite the faculty's desire for increased student input with the student body's desire for increased representation by advocating for more student representatives to these academic councils.

As a team, Jacob and I excel at direct communication, transparency, and work under pressure. We have the internal experience required to run SGLC, as well as the external connections to the greater Loyola community to accomplish our goals. We are committed to listening to the concerns of student voices across campus, promoting changes that benefit the larger student body, and advocating on behalf of the student body to administrators.
