PASS/NO-PASS, RULES

- Students may change from Pass/No-Pass to the regular grading system, or vice versa, only during the first two weeks of the regular semester and the first week of a summer session and the second day of J term.
- This option is available to a student with a minimum of sophomore standing (30+ earned credit hours) in good academic standing who has satisfied the course prerequisites (or has the written permission of the course instructor).
- A maximum of twelve credit hours may be taken under the pass/no pass option during a student's undergraduate career. The credits will be included in the total number of hours earned toward graduation but will not enter into the computation of the cumulative grade point average. A student may not take more than two Pass/No Pass courses in any one academic session. Grades of "P" for advanced placement courses that are accepted as transfer credit are not included in the 12-credit-hour total.
- Only electives can be taken under the pass no-pass option. Permission will not be given for core, engaged learning, major or minor course requirements. Professional courses in education required for certification **cannot** be taken Pass/No Pass. The undergraduate Pass/No Pass Policy can be found here.
- Under the Pass/No Pass option, the grades of A-, A+, B+, B-, C+, C-, will be assigned a "P," for "Pass" and the grades D+, D, F will be assigned "NP," for "No-Pass."
- "P" and "NP" grades will appear on the official record of the student's work taken at Loyola University, and **may not be converted to any other grade**. Credit hours with grades of "P" under this option will not be included in the minimum 60 graded Loyola hours that must be completed to be eligible for academic honors at graduation.
