- No more than twenty pages (including references).
- Submitted as a Microsoft Word document file (.doc or .docx).
- Double spaced, Times New Roman 12-point font, one-inch margins, and APA format.
- Make sure all identifying information, including contact information, appears only on the cover page.
- BSW, MSW, and PhD students and alumni are invited to submit.
