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Reduce!

- Double side print to save paper!
- Email information instead of printing flyers
- Use non-disposable water bottles
 - Find the nearest refill station! 55+ of these all over campus



Reuse!

- Purchase supplies that contain post-consumer recycled content
- Use refillable pens and pencils



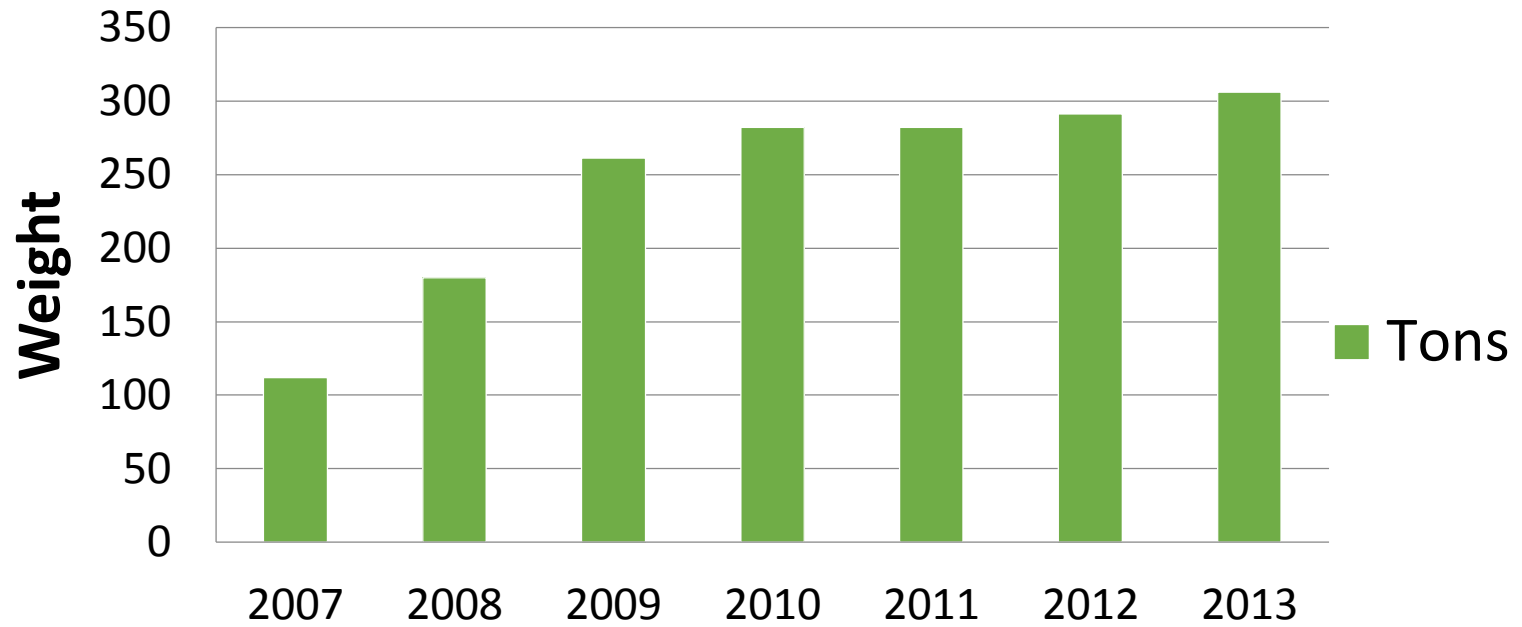
- Acquire furniture, clothing and many other items from a resale shop = Reuse!
- Donate, repair or sell used items instead of throwing them away
- Use old flyers and paper as scratch paper

Recycling: What goes where?

- Paper, Cardboard, Glass, Cans, Containers **#1-5** and **#7 ONLY** go in recycle bins
- Bins all over campus and in residence halls
- **NOT RECYCLABLE:** paper towels, Styrofoam, tissues, food wrappers and greasy pizza boxes

Recyclemania and LUC!



- A national competition between universities to measure and compare recycling rates over an eight-week period
- In 2014 LUC recycled 153,910 pounds during the 8 weeks
 - Equivalent to 55 cars off the road
 - Equivalent to reducing 282 metric tons of CO₂

Recycle Batteries, Ink Cartridges, and All Electronics!



- **Keep these OUT of the landfill!**
- They are safe to use at home but contain TOXIC metals and chemicals, which can be released into the environment when end up in landfills.
- **Special collection bins around campus**
 - 1st floor of the IC for batteries
 - The Hub Sullivan Center for batteries
 - Digital Media Labs to drop off cell phones, cartridges and small e-notebooks
- **Laptops and other electronics**
- **Return to place of business where purchased**
 - Laws in Illinois require businesses to accept and e-recycle responsibly

Composting!

- Composting bins available to on-campus students with weekly drop offs
 - Fruit, veggies, bread, baked goods, chips, coffee, tea, dairy, meats, white or brown paper towels, Aramark's compostable serving ware
- 80-100 tons of plate-waste generated monthly from main dining halls on campus
 - Put these resources to use and compost!
