Biographical/Administrative History

Born January 18, 1936, Enid Devira Levien grew up in the Hyde Park neighborhood on the South Side of Chicago. She graduated from Hyde Park High School in 1953 then attended University of Chicago, graduating in 1957 with a degree in Spanish. In December of that year, she married Lewis Raisman Baron and raised a family. Baron returned to higher education later in life, earning a master's degree in 1971 and doctorate in 1976 in clinical psychology from Northwestern University. She worked at Mundelein College as the Director of Counseling and as a home economics instructor, maintained a private practice, and worked at Northwestern as a college counselor.

Baron also had a talent for writing poetry, creative nonfiction, and short stories. She volunteered with the Poetry Center of Chicago, serving as vice president for a period. A book of her original poems, *Baking Days*, was published in 1994. Baron taught poetry workshops to school children and memoir writing at the Levy Senior Center in Evanston. The latter project resulted in a collection of memoirs from class participants, *Weaving the Threads*. Baron passed away in October 2022.

Scope and Content
