### **Administrative History**

Church Women United (CWU) is a denominationally inclusive Christian women's organization that strives for social justice and world peace. Originally named United Council of Church Women, the national organization was founded December 8, 1941, one day following the attack on Pearl Harbor.

The Elgin chapter of Church Women United was founded in 1957. The chapter was initially called United Church Women of Elgin, but changed to Church Women United to coincide with the national organization changing to Church Women United. The Elgin chapter is one of more than 100 CWU chapters affiliated with Church Women United in Illinois. CWU Elgin takes part in many national and international events that promote prayer and peace including World Day of Prayer, World Community Day, the Human Rights Celebration, and May Friendship Day (called May Fellowship Day until 1998). The Elgin chapter also supports many local, national, and international charities. In 1970, the Church Women United Elgin expanded the chapter to include South Elgin.

One of the most significant contributions to the Elgin community was the creation of Meals on Wheels in 1972. Created and led by Shirley Minks, CWU Elgin was in charge of planning, delivery, volunteers, bookkeeping, and other administrative aspects of the program until 2013.

Church Women United of Elgin began considering disbanding in 2013 due to low membership, and officially disbanded in January of 2013 after 56 years in operation.

## **Scope and Content**

### **Series 1: Administration, 1941-2013, Boxes 1-4**

This series contains annual records, meeting minutes, correspondence, and other institutional records related to Church Women United. The series is grouped within three subjects, Annual Records, Meeting Minutes, and General, all of which are organized chronologically.

### **Series 2: Programs and Events, 1957-2013, Boxes 4-5**

This series contains material relating to the programs and events sponsored or organized by Church Women United Elgin. Including event programs, newspaper articles, pamphlets, and records for World Day of Prayer, World Community Day, Human Rights Celebration, May Friendship Day, and Meals on Wheels.

### **Series 3: Affiliated Organizations, 1976-2012, Boxes 5, 8**

This series contains material related to the organizations and charities that the CWU Elgin supported. Materials include correspondence, programs, and brochures. One oversized object was placed in Box 8.

### **Series 4: Publications, 1975-2012, Box 6**

This series contains the *Illinois Interpreter* published by Church Women United in Illinois, a booklet published by CWU titled *A Guidebook for a Global Society* and copies of the *Public Policy* newsletter published by the Illinois Conference of Churches.

### **Series 5: Scrapbooks, 1957-2013, Boxes 7-8**

This series consists of scrapbooks created by CWU Elgin members. Four of the scrapbooks contain newspaper articles, photographs, programs, and certificates relating to CWU Elgin activities from 1957-2013. The fifth scrapbook consists only of material related to the Meals on Wheels program and includes newspaper articles, photographs, and records of the program.
