OR

Find an archives that specializes in your interests!

Archives have specialized collections; they can collect items from specific:

*groups/individuals *locations/places *belief systems *subject areas The WLA collects records from women and women's organizations in Chicago

Subjects include: activism,
women's issues, authors,
education, environmental issues,
public service, social justice,
religious women, and the fine,
performance, & visual arts.

Look at the finding aids for a general subject matter, conflict, event, or theme that interests you.

Then, narrow it down– find specific organizations or people involved with your general topic to find distinct impacts, details, and primary sources. Look at the finding aids for a specific organization or person involved in a subject matter, conflict, event, or theme that interests you.

Then, if this is too narrow, use these primary sources to find more people, themes, or organizations involved.

Subjects/themes related to the collection


Materials included in the collection


These finding aids can help you identify:
