Administrative History

FutureChurch is an Ohio-based organization which aims to reform the Catholic Church. Their mission statement asserts: "FutureChurch seeks changes that will provide all Roman Catholics the opportunity to participate fully in Church life and leadership." The group advocates open worship, priesthood open to both men and women, and optional celibacy for priests.

FutureChurch is not part of the diocesan structure, but is an independent group working for social justice within the Catholic Church.

The group started as a reaction to the shortage of Catholic priests in the United States in the early 1990s. One of the central goals of the organization is to remedy this shortage to allow for a "full celebration of Eucharist." FutureChurch maintains that allowing married men and women into the Catholic priesthood would end this problem by increasing the availability of priests and the Eucharist to all Catholics. The organization sponsors educational talks and conducts mailing campaigns, among a range of other activities, in efforts to convince the Church of this solution. Still active today, FutureChurch was co-founded by Christine Schenk of the Congregation of St. Joseph (CSJ) order.

Scope of Context

This collection is divided into three series and consists of 11.5 linear ft., spanning the years 1991 to 2011 as well as contains some undated material. The collection is organized alphabetically, then chronologically when appropriate, within each series. Most of the material relates to the group's initiatives and programs. Some of the material relates to Corpus Christi, a church that was removed from the diocese for the participation of a female deacon. Photographs in the collection focus on events and programs from FutureChurch. Many news articles are included in the collection as well. These images are related to topics such as: the future of priestly ministries, Mary of Magdala, and priest sex abuse. There is some digital content in this collection, including

photographs and administrative documents. **Please speak to a WLA staff member for assistance with the digital collection.**

In November 2014, 6 linear feet of material was incorporated from the FutureChurch Addendum 1 collection, because of similar subjects and/or overlapping dates. This material is pertinent for some of the collection's subject files and speakers materials. See relevant notes below.

Series 1: Administrative, 1991-2011, n.d., Box 1-6

This series contains general administrative documents for the organization including: meeting minutes from committees, financial information, mailings, and subject files on many news articles that were distributed, collected and used as part of FutureChurch's program.

Some of the materials in the subject files were originally donated with the FutureChurch Addendum 1, but because of similar topics and/or overlapping dates, were placed into this collection's subject files. This pertains to the subject files of Mary of Magdala, Sex Abuse, and Women's Ordination Articles.

Series 2: Series: Programs and Campaigns, 1991-2011, n.d., Box 6-10.

This series includes material related to outreach programs and campaigns carried out by FutureChurch, including: copies of program packets, conferences notes, annual dinner preparations and programs for events, material related to speakers, and the group's Rome pilgrimage. Topics covered include: women witnesses, optional celibacy, and future priestly ministries.

Some of the speakers files have material that originally came subsequent to this collection's creation, as part of the FutureChurch Addendum 1. Because they were part of the same event, the items have been placed into this collection's speakers materials.

The collection is organized alphabetically, then chronologically, when appropriate, within each series (exceptions are noted). Most of the material relates to the group's daily operations, initiatives, programs, publications, and public

events. Other materials are pertinent to organizations with similar missions who cooperate with FutureChurch, such as Chicago-based Call to Action. Subjects that are spread among the series include Mary of Magdala, women's ordination, celibacy, and contemporary issues in the church.

There is also some audiovisual content in this collection, including photographs, video home systems (VHS), compact discs (CD), and audiocassettes. The majority of the photographs pertain to FutureChurch public functions as do the VHS, CD and audiocassette materials. Call to Action is the second group prominently featured in the audiovisual material, for the most part dominating the audiocassette subseries.

Series 1: Administrative, 1991-2012, n.d.

This series contains two subseries of material relating to the daily operation of Future Church from its founding through today, as well as an associated organization, Call to Action (a Catholic renewal organization based in Chicago, IL). The series content is diverse and includes: founding documents, organizational resources, learning resources, correspondence, administrative and leadership documents, newsletters, membership lists, meeting minutes from committees and mailing and media materials. In addition, there are subject files covering various issues in the church such as the priest shortage, celibacy, as well as the organization and financials of the Catholic Church. Some of this addendum's subject files reside in the original FutureChurch collection due to an overlap of similar topics and dates. These include St. Mary of Magdala, Sex Abuse, and Women's Ordination Articles.

Subseries 1A: Administration of FutureChurch, 1991-2012, n.d.

The materials in this subseries include founding and organizational documents, scheduling and planning materials, reviews, evaluations, reports, resources, and publicity and media.

Subseries 1B: Call to Action, 1994-2004, n.d.

The contents of this subseries include a selection of administrative and planning documents that relate to activities sponsored by or in collaboration with state and regional chapters of Call to Action.

Significant to note in relation to Call to Action is the collection currently held at DePaul University (Chicago, IL), which potentially contains similar types and/or copies of documents and manuscripts in this series.

Series 2: Campaigns, Events, and Programs, 1991-2014, n.d.

This series includes activities and events conducted in public view and for public audiences; including campaigns, celebrations, religious services (some of which translated into Spanish), conferences, programs, speakers, dinners, benefits, and workshops. A portion of the materials pertaining to FutureChurch speakers that arrived as part of this addendum, are held in the original Future Church collection as they contain the same information and/or have corresponding dates. These public activities relate to the presence and history of women in the church, the declining numbers of men in the priesthood, inclusive practices, the rejuvenation of the Catholic Church, and various fundraising efforts.

Series 3: Publications, 1980-2009, n.d.

This series contains materials in a variety of forms including books, articles, pamphlets, newspapers, and magazines published by FutureChurch, its cooperating organizations, in addition to organizations which oppose FutureChurch activities. The specific subjects of these publications vary, but all relate to contemporary and controversial issues in the Catholic Church such as women's ordination, the priest shortage, Catholic practices, and clerical abuses.

Series 4: Audiovisual Materials, 1991-2012, n.d.

The audio and visual materials included in this series are separated into five distinct subseries: 3.5" Floppy, Audiocassettes, Compact Discs, Photographs, and Video Home Systems.

Subseries 4A: Photographs, 1998-2012, n.d.

The photographs of this subseries are from public events proposed, supported, or attended by FutureChurch participants and/or Call to Action members.

Subseries 4B: Audiocassettes, 1991-2005, n.d.

This subseries is the most extensive of the Audiovisual Materials and contains items from not just FutureChurch, but also Call to Action, Voice of the Faithful, and other religious-based affiliated organizations. The audiocassettes range in content and include interviews, lectures, workshops, presentations, speakers, debates, and radio shows advocated, sponsored, or attended by FutureChurch staff. This subseries is first grouped by organization/type of cassette, and secondly by date.

It is significant to note that Call to Action also has a collection at DePaul University (Chicago, IL), which potentially contains similar and/or replicas of tapes in this subseries.

Subseries 4C: 3.5" Floppy, 2000-2002, n.d.

This subseries consists of 3.5" floppy disks containing FutureChurch files.

Subseries 4D: Compact Discs, 1999, n.d.

This subseries contains recordings of lectures, discussions, and speeches proposed, supported, or attended by FutureChurch and Call to Action staff.

Subseries 4E: Video Home Systems, 1991-2000, n.d.

The contents of the Video Home System (VHS) subseries are recordings from public events organized, supported, or attended by FutureChurch participants or Call to Action members. Locations of photographs are spread across the United States.
