**Administrative History**

In order to establish a fund-raising arm for Massachusetts Women-Church, Marie Sheehan, Sr. Claire O'Rourke, and a number of Massachusetts women organized Lost Coin Women's Fund, Inc. (LCWF), a charitable organization. The mission of the organization is to provide grants to low-income Massachusetts women so they may attend an undergraduate institution or vocational training program. The organization was established in 1992 and has assisted hundreds of women in need since its inception.
