Administrative History

Centro Educativo de Nuevo Mundo in Guayaquil, Ecuador, was founded in 1979 as an experiment in Catholic social justice. It is a school in which funds from a morning program and families with adequate financial resources are used to subsidize a school for the very poor in the afternoon. The morning school is a Catholic bi-lingual grade and high school (K-12). Its 700 morning students came from the middle and upper classes. The afternoon school brought in 400 students from the poorest sections of Guayaquil. For them, Fundacion de Nuevo Mundo provided the same high-quality grade school (K-6), as well as a technical high-school curriculum which enabled students to expand their practical knowledge. Often, Morning school children and their parents volunteer in the afternoon school. Parents of afternoon school students provided in-kind services or were employed by Nuevo Mundo and occasionally by the parents of morning school children.

Founders of Nuevo Mundo were Pat McTeague and Sony Rendon. They met in Quito, Ecuador where Pat, then a BVM, was teaching. Subsequently Ecuadorian Rendon came to the United States and Mundelein College, Chicago, to study. The blueprint for this experimental project was presented by Sonya Rendon as partial fulfillment for her master's degree in Religious Studies. Nuevo Mundo, opened in 1979, celebrated its first commencement in 1991 when eighty-one young men and women were graduated.

Scope and Content

These records span from 1957-2004 and cover the founding of Nuevo Mundo; the academic and professional records of Pat McTeague and Sonya Rendon; the administration and operation of Nuevo Mundo; audio and video cassettes of interviews with the founders and personnel of the school; and photographs of Nuevo Mundo activities. Several of the documents are in Spanish.
